# **LOOKING AHEAD TO 2021 AND BEYOND...** KEY WIRE AND CABLE APPLICATION SECTORS IN THE REGION

#### AUTOMOTIVE

Ultra-light and heat-resistant cables, wires, springs, screws and meshes • increasing use of polymer optic fibres

- By 2025, 60% of global automotive output will come from Asia-Pac
- ASEAN's investment in passenger electric vehicles to reach US\$6 billion by 2030

#### **ELECTRICAL & ELECTRONICS**

Four groups in this sector will account for 75% of robotic automation installations by 2025: electrical equipment, appliances and components; computers and electronic products; transport equipment; and machinery.
